SLIPPERS INSPIRATION #CA-02(e)



REMARK: Read the entire pattern before beginning.

* See page 4 for specifications and page 5 for diagram.

INSTRUCTION

With Eggplant yarn and double pointed needles 4.0mm, cast on 60 sts (15 sts per needle). Work 12 rows in Broken ribs (see stitches section on page 4).

Continue working as per diagram on page 5. Work rows 1 to 42 decreasing of 1 stitch per needle on rows 31 and 41. You will have 52 sts (13 sts per needle).

HEEL

With Eggplant yarn, knit sts from needles 1 and 2. You will have 26 sts on one needle. Turn.

Slip first stitch purlwise and purl to the end of row.

Row 1: *Sl1, K1 *. Repeat from * to * to the end of row. Turn.

Row 2: Slip first stitch purlwise and purl to the end of row. Turn.

Repeat these 2 rows until you have 22 rows. The last row is purled.

For the next section, we give the instructions in stockinette stitch but you

can also continue this section with above mentioned rows 1 and 2:

- 1. Knit until you have 10 stitches letft on left needle. SKPO (slip1, K1, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch). You have 8 stitches remaining on left needle. Keep them on hold. Turn.
- 2. Slip 1 purlwise, P6, P2tog. You will have 8 stitches remaining on left needle. Keep them on hold. Turn.
- 3. Slip 1, K6, SKPO (to do the SKPO, you will use the first stitch of the 8 stitches on hold, pass slip stitch over the knit stitch). You have 7 stitches remaining on left needle. Keep them on hold. Turn.
- 4. Slip 1, P6, P2 tog. (to do the P2tog, you will use the first stitch of the 8 stitches on hold). You have 7 stitches remaining on left needle. Keep them on hold. Turn.

Continue until all stitches on each side are gone. You have 8 stitches on the needle. Divide them on 2 needles.

Knit the 4 stitches of needle 1, cast on 12 stitches from side of the heel, (needle 1: 16 stitches), knit the 13 stitches of needle 2, knit the 13 stitches of needle 3, cast on 12 stitches from side of the heel, knit 4 last stitches (needle 4: 16 stitches).

After casting on the 12 stitches on each side of the heel, the stitches will be divided as follows:

From middle of the heel:

Needle 1: 16 stitches Needle 2: 13 stitches Needle 3: 13 stitches Needle 4: 16 stitches

TO DECREASE GUSSET

K2tog at the end of needle 1. Knit stitches from needles 2 and 3. SKPO at the beginning of the needle 4.

Repeat 2 more times for a total of 3 rows of decreases. You have 52 stitches (13 stitches per needle).

Following diagram, continue with rows 43 and following rows.

Add or remove rows according to the length of feet. To add rows, repeat rows of pattern from the diagram as desired.

For the length of foot, refer to the website www.tricotmouton.com on the "Charts and Guides" page for size charts. You will be able to know the number of centimeters according to the size of shoe. (Note that you will need to take the measurement minus 3.5 cm The 3.5 cm being the length for the tip of the foot)

TOES SECTION

With Eggplant yarn, continue in stockinette stitch as follows:

At the end of each needle, K2tog from back loop. Repeat until you have 2 stitches per needle. Cut yarn and pull-it through the remaining stitches.

Gauge:

Sample on 10cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") 22 sts x 31 rows

If your sample is different in dimension from what is mentioned above, use larger or smaller needles.

NOTE: Jacquard knits (knitted with several colors) are less stretchable than knits of one color.

MINI-CABLES

Broken Rib (Tricot-Mouton version):

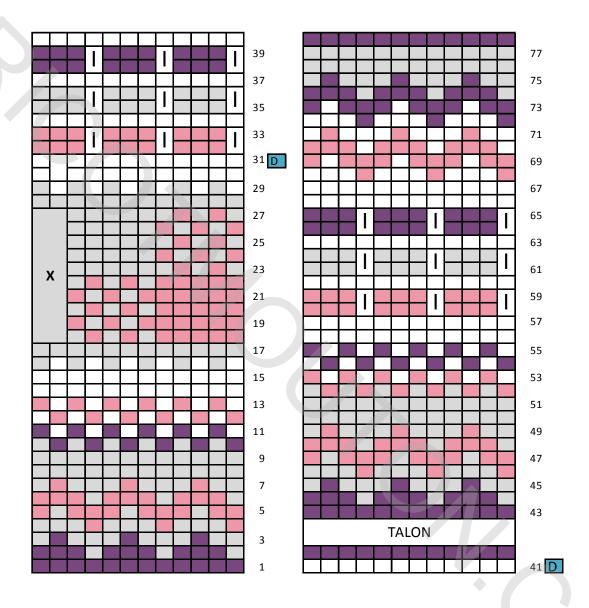
Row 1: Knit to the end of row

Row 2: *K1, P1*. Repeat from * to * to

then end of row
